

# **PUBLISHER'S NOTE**

**SPRING 2025** marks my third year as the publisher of Greystone Books, and my passion for the work we do here has grown over that time. When people ask about the kind of books we publish, I often say that our focus is on promoting the health and well-being of both people and the planet. This mission encompasses a broad range of topics, all of which are reflected in the books on this list. Increasingly, however, these two realms—human health and planetary health—are intertwined, with each deeply influencing the other.

This critical connection is at the heart of one of our lead titles this spring, *Climate Injustice*. In this powerful work, renowned climate scientist Friederike Otto examines climate change as a symptom of the broader global crisis of inequality. While climate change is unquestionably wreaking havoc on the natural world, it is also devastating human lives and livelihoods. Otto draws comparisons between extreme weather events—such as heat waves in North America, floods in Pakistan, droughts in Madagascar, and wildfires in Australia—to illustrate how climate change and extreme weather are disproportionately impacting the world's most vulnerable populations. From women working on farms in Ghana during intense heat waves to the elderly who perished in floods in Germany, she exposes the harsh realities of how social and political infrastructures are failing to protect those most at risk.

Many of the books featured in these pages foster an appreciation for the natural world, but to secure a healthy future for humankind, we must act—and vote—with the planet's health in mind.


**CLIMATE CHANGE DOES** not affect us all equally. Its impact on the most vulnerable is particularly noticeable in extreme weather events, which are increasing in intensity and frequency. While many climate scientists view climate change solely as an abstract physics problem, Friederike Otto argues that it is a symptom of the global crisis of inequality. Comparing eight extreme weather events—from heat waves in North America and droughts in Madagascar to wildfires in Australia and floods in Pakistan—Otto shows how each one reveals uncomfortable truths about the failures of political and social infrastructure around the world. Above all, she demonstrates what climate justice actually means, who is to blame, and what needs to be done about it—both now and in our ongoing climate future.

**FRIEDERIKE OTTO** is a physicist and doctor of philosophy. At the Grantham Institute for Climate Change and the Environmen at Imperial College London, she researches extreme weather and its effects on society. As co-founder of World Weather Attribution, she is one of a handful of scientists around the world who can calculate in real time how much climate change impacts our weather. In 2021, she was named one of *Time*'s 100 Most Influential People and one of *Nature*'s ten people who helped shape science.





**PETER WOHLLEBEN** is the author of numerous books, including the *New* York Times bestseller The Hidden Life of Trees and The Inner Life of Animals.



IN A VILLAGE in northern France, Jean, a pharmacist's son, and Johnny, the son of a sheepherder, discover a shared talent for mimicking bird calls. As they hone their talents on the European bird-calling competition circuit, the two boys' identities become distinct: Jean is soft-spoken, while Johnny likes to play to the crowd. Most of their competitors are adult men, often hunters who learned bird calling for sport. But the two boys are fascinated with transcending the boundary between humans and birds through the pure beauty and poetry of birdsong.

The Bird Singers intricately weaves family stories and ornithological passion into a poetic, powerful narrative about the miracles of nature, life, and friendship.

JEAN BOUCAULT and JOHNNY RASSE first learned to imitate bird calls as children in northern France. Their rivalry at bird-calling competitions gave way to friendship, and eventually to a partnership as performers. Although Boucault and Rasse are trained as a pharmacist and engineer respectively, their passion for birds led them to create a stage show under the name Les chanteurs d'oiseaux (the Bird Singers), record an album, and tour in France and internationally.







Over the past decade, she has focused on Indigenous knowledge systems and the use of story, song, place, and art as mnemonic devices. She is the author of the bestsellers The Memory Code, Memory Craft, and Songlines.


IN THE ART OF PHYSICS, Zahaan Bharmal explains eight ideas from physics that have transformed his view of everyday life and will do the same for you.
